## Job Skills Training Programs

### Literacy and Work-Related Skills

This training program provides specialized instruction to assist students to develop literacy, employability and work related skills. Lessons are designed to enable the student to participate in work and group activities. Program is up to 3 years in length (6 consecutive semesters)

<b>Class Meets:</b>	Monday through Friday
<b>Cost:</b>	\$45 per semester
<b>Requirements:</b>	18 years old or older Documented Intellectual Disability

## Career Exploration Training Programs

### Realizing Exceptional Achievements at a Community Hospital (REACH)

In partnership with St. Joseph's Hospital, this program provides experiences for those 18-22 y/o in a hospital setting that will enable each student to explore career options, learn job skills, utilize public transportation and ultimately obtain employment as a self-advocating independent community member.

Location: St. Joseph's Hospital

### Successful Transition After Graduation for Exceptional Students (STAGES)

In partnership with the University of South Florida (USF) College of Education, this program provides experiences for those 18-22 y/o on a college campus. Each student will explore career options, learn job skills, utilize public transportation and ultimately obtain employment as a self-advocating independent community member.

Location: University of South Florida

<b>Class times:</b>	Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 2:30 pm
<b>Cost:</b>	\$45 per semester plus cost of insurance (\$25.20 annually) <i>May attend for up to 2 years</i>
<b>Requirements:</b>	18—22 years old Documented Intellectual Disability Successful screening score



## Specialized Training Programs

### Hotel Front of House Associate

This training program offers technical training in preparation for work in the hospitality industry. The program will include but is not limited to providing technical skill proficiencies for guest relation services, kitchen assistant, laundry attendant, luggage handler and room service. All training is gained through practical experiences at The Barrymore Hotel Riverwalk Tampa.

Classes are M-F 8:00 am-2:00 pm for 1 year @ approximately \$3000.

### Merchandise Handler Training

Prepares the student for merchandise handling, inventory, stocking, tagging and organizing. All training is gained through practical experiences at the Brandon Town Center Macy's Department Store.

Classes are M-F 8:00 am-2:00 pm for 10 months @ approximately \$2500.

**Cost** above includes tuition, fees, insurance and uniforms. Funding assistance may be available.

**Requirements :** 18 y/o or older  
Proof of residency  
Documented intellectual disability

*All programs require own transportation to and from school.*
